U.S. INVASION

The Danbury Brass Band from Connecticut, USA, will be landing in the Hills with a "Spectacular Band Concert" in the William Clarke College Performing Arts Hall, Wednesday 4 August at 8:00pm.

Danbury Brass, under the Baton of Mr Alan Raph, is a 28-piece loosely structured British Brass Band with an American Spirit. They play music which spans and samples Baroque, Romantic, and Contemporary periods as well as folk songs, jazz, marches, instrumental solos, and ethnic music with most of their repertoire specifically arranged or written for their ensemble.

Danbury Brass will be well supported by the popular "Northside Concert Band", directed by Mr Ross Cole, and the Hills' Districts own award winning "Clefhangers Concert Band" started 6 years ago by local musician and Band Director, Mr Mark Strykowski.

This is the second trip to Australia for the Danbury Brass Band, but their first to the Hills. Clefhangers Band Director, Mark Strykowski, says "audiences will be in for a treat at this concert with an extra special massed band finale - Come along and be entertained!"

Danbury Brass will continue to perform throughout Australia during August with performances in Manly, Gosford, Cairns and Darwin.
